Participants will learn and develop new skills and build confidence, working with other adults in recovery. The workshops are open to all abilities with no previous experience needed.

Each week we will spend two hours exploring a new aspect of participatory applied theatre and drama practice with experienced facilitators and have fun in a creative space! The weekly sessions can be drop-in but you would benefit most by committing to attending every week and completing the whole project, see below for details.
